



Install PS2181-2 Drawer Cabinet Rollers INSTRUCTION MANUAL

TOOL(S) NEEDED:

• 3/8" Nut driver, wrench,

or socket

 7/16" Nut driver, wrench, or socket • 1/2" Wrench or socket

Phillips screwdriver

Lock-Tite - red (for revision #2)

• RTV (for revision#3)

KIT CONTENTS:


This kit contains parts for three different versions of rollers. Refer to photos to determine which revision you have and what parts are to be used to install new rollers.


- 1. Circle plate (2)
- 2. 1/4" Nut (2)
- 3. 10-32" Nylock nut (2)
- 4. 1/4" Nylock nut (2)
- 5. Lock washer (2)
- 6. Hex plate (8)
- 7. Steel bushing (2)
- 8. Plastic bushing (2)
- 9. 10-32"x 7/8" Screw and 7/16" bushing (2)
- 10. 1/4-20 Bolt (2)
- 11. Roller (2)
- 12. Washer with large hole (2)
- 13. Washer with small hole (2)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Roller Revision 1 - see photo at right. If your rollers match the photo at right, you have Revision 1.

- 1. Remove old roller assembly by removing shoulder screw, washer, and roller. Discard all.
- 2. Place new plastic bushing (item #8) thru new roller (item # 11).
- 3. Insert new washer with large hole (item #12) inside roller.
- 4. Insert new shoulder screw (item #9) through roller with washer assembly and place it in the cabinet. Tighten securely.





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Roller Revision 2 - see photo at right. If your rollers match this photo, you have Revision 2.

- Remove old roller assembly by removing nut, washers, bushings, and roller. Discard all.
- 2. Place new steel bushing (item #7) inside a new plastic bushing (item #8).
- 3. Place bushing assembly inside new roller (item #11).
- 4. Place roller/bushing assembly onto bolt inside appliance cavity.
- 5. Apply a small amount of Loc-Tite onto threads of bolt to help hold nut in place.
- 6. Place new washer with small hole (item #13), lock washer (item #5), and 1/4" nut (item #2) onto bolt and tighten securely.

Roller Revision 3 - see photo at right. If your rollers matches this photo, you have Revision 3.

- 1. Remove old roller assembly by removing bolt, washer, bushings, and roller. Discard all.
- 2. Place new steel bushing (item #7) inside a new plastic bushing (item #8).
- 3. Place bushing assembly into new roller (item #11).
- 4. Apply washer with small hole (item #13) to inside of roller and place new 1/4-20 bolt (item #10) thru entire assembly.
- 5. Once bolt is inserted, place in cabinet and tighten securely.

To Replace Roller Revision 2 with Roller Revision 3

- 1. Remove outer cover from appliance to access mounting brackets.
- Remove existing hardware (save nuts for reuse) from two studs and remove old RTV from around hole.
- 3. After cleaning surface apply new RTV around mounting hole and place one hex plate (item #6) on studs.
- 4. Set 1/4" Nylock nut (item #4) in hex plate and align to hole.
- 5. Apply three more hex plates (item #6) on top of nut and then place the circle plate (item #1) to secure nut.
- 6. Hand tighten two 10-32 Nylock nuts (item #3 reuse those removed in step 2, there are two extras included in kit) onto studs on outside of appliance cavity.
- 7. With the nuts only hand tight, install roller assembly as described in the Roller Revision 3 above.
- 8. Tightened bolt securely, then tighten two nuts on the outside of the cavity.
- 9. Replace outer cover on appliance using pop rivets or small sheet metal screws (not provided).

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
