

In the last five years commodities prices have increased.




Commodities Price Increase Since 2019

Foodservice jobs have recovered to near the level they were at just before pandemic shutdowns hit.



Wage Growth for US Restaurant Workers



Annual staffing turnover continues to be high. It peaked during shutdowns but has returned to the 80% range.
