## **TOOL(S) NEEDED**

- Large Channel Locks or Pipe Wrench
- AC1022-2 Kit



Pefore servicing the fryer ensure that the fryer is shut off, unplugged, and the oil is drained from the pot.

2.Using a large pair of channel locks or a pipe wrench, Untighten the front leg. Using your hands, unscrew the leg.(Fig.2-3)
