

AC1027 Stem Caster Shim Kit

TOOL(S) NEEDED

- Small Floor Jack
- 3/4" Wrench



1. Identify the caster you want to shim. Place the floor jack near the caster and lift the unit up approximately one inch.

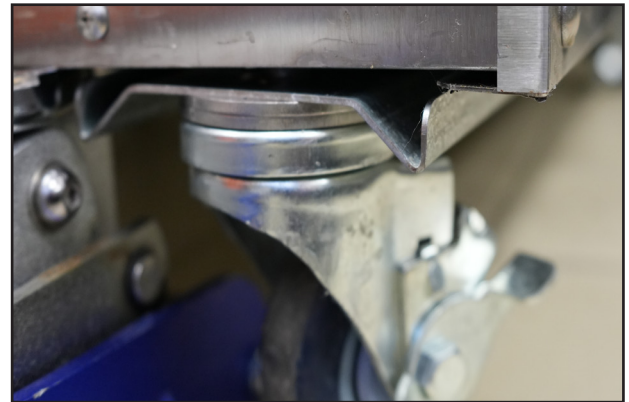


2. Determine how many shims are needed to level the cabinet. Each shim is 1/8" thick. It is recommended not to use more than five shims.

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3. Locate the stem caster bolt head. Using a 3/4" wrench, loosen the stem caster enough to accommodate the required number of shims.



4. Insert the shims onto the stem caster. Ensure that the shims are between the caster base and the cabinet base or the cross support if present.



5. Locate the stem caster bolt head. Using a 3/4" wrench, tighten the stem caster.

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6. Lower the cabinet. Repeat the process for any other caster that requires shims.

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
