

# Application of Appliance ID Tag for Fryer Upgrade Kits

## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

**TOOL(S) NEEDED:** • Clean damp cloth • Soap and water  
• Clean dry cloth

**KIT CONTENTS:**

Upgrade kit including one Appliance ID tag

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. The upgrade kit will have a new appliance ID tag attached to the front of the fryer front panel as show in Figure 1.

2. **CAUTION: Disconnect power to the appliance before performing this step.** There will be an additional ID tag supplied separately in the upgrade kit. This ID tag must be applied to the inside right rear wall panel of the fryer in the location shown in Figure 2. Note: BEFORE APPLYING

THE NEW TAG, thoroughly clean the area where the tag will go with soap and clean water until all traces of oil or any other residue is gone. If there is already an ID tag in the area, leave the old ID tag in place and apply the new tag from the upgrade kit near the old ID tag (either next to it, above it, or below it). DO NOT place the new ID tag on top of the old ID tag. Both tags need to be accessible. DO NOT place the new ID tag on or near any electrical or heat generating components. Peel the backing off the new tag and carefully place it by adhering one edge and working toward the unstuck edge while smoothing the ID tag out as you go along. Make sure to have all bubbles in the ID tag removed.

Remove this panel. Apply new Appliance ID Tag to upper right on the inner wall panel.

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
